**Description of Property and Justification: (Please attach map and photo)**

Although the Brandt USARC is a modern building, it is located on property that has military use during World War I. In the rear of the property there were two mirrored Victorian structures built in 1918 which were used for headquarters of the Army during World War I. One of these structures was so badly deteriorated it has been demolished, and the existing structure is also severely deteriorated. Nearby, a one story frame structure, built in 1941, was used for storage of military vehicles, and is currently used for general storage. Also on the property is a cinderblock garage and a steel-frame garage.

The Army Reserve Centers do not appear to meet the Criteria for Evaluation for inclusion in the National Register of Historic Places. The Reserve Centers do not meet Criteria A or B, as research has not revealed an association with a significant event or individual. The Reserve Centers do not meet Criterion C, as they do not embody the distinctive characteristics of a type, period, or method of construction, represent the work of a master, or possess high artistic values. In very general terms, the original World War I structures used for the Army Reserve Center were two identical, typical American Four-Square type structures which deteriorated after they were abandoned. One structure was demolished, and the second is in a state of near-collapse. Because of its condition, it is not considered eligible for National Register eligibility.

Finally, no information has been found that would qualify the resource under Criterion D for its potential to yield information



RESOURCE SKETCH MAP


