The Warfield/Clark Cemetery has graves dating to the 19th century but the majority of the burials have taken place since 1950, the most recent dating to 2004. The site is marked as the "Hospital Chapel Cemetery" on the Odenton USGS quad sheet. Nineteen stone markers were visible at this cemetery. The cemetery is located at the end of a dirt road, approximately one-half mile northwest of the Fort Meade High School. This cemetery does not contain the graves of any persons of transcendent importance, is not associated with historic events, does not possess distinctive design features, and is not of significant age. The site has limited research potential so does not meet NRHP Criteria Consideration D. The Warfield/Clark Cemetery is therefore ineligible for listing in the NRHP.
