<p>The Armiger House is believed to have been built by the same Shipwright and house carpenter as nearby "White Oak" (AA-42-L-A). (#250) Other than the similarity of these two houses there is no substantiation to this tale.</p> <p>The house stands on a large farm. It is invisible from the road, at the end of a long tree-lined lane. The owner plans to begin a restoration project this year.</p> <p>A two story ^{or} fine structure on the traditional side-hall, double-parlor, plan, the main house has two large exterior chimneys with a brick pent closet between them. There is a small, one story, kitchen attached to the rear of the house by a low, enclosed breezeway. The kitchen chimney also serves a small loft room lit by tiny end windows. The shed-roofed, enclosed, porch on the east side of the kitchen and breezeway is a 20th century addition.</p> <p>The house appears to have its original siding. A screened porch over the front entrance and a brick furnace room beside the south chimney are recent additions.</p> <p>This property has belonged to the Armiger family for many generations. The present owner has records and diaries from the early 19th century, pertaining to the family and the land.</p> <p>The names Benjamin C. Neff and D. Neff are recorded on the 1860 and 1878 county maps as respective owners of the farm.</p>
