DESCRIBE THE PRESENT AND ORIGINAL (If known) PHYSICAL APPEARANCE

The larger of the two tobacco barns on this farm was built in the mid 19th century. It is in good condition and is still in use. The original frame has been completely surrounded by shed additions which date from the early 1900's. The shingle roof has been covered with galvanized metal. Some of the shed siding, judging from its width and state of weathering, may have come from the original structure. The framing has not been altered. The timbers are massive: 10" x 10" sills run the length of the barn in one piece. There is no "drive-through" bay as in later barns. The cedar columns and oak sills rest on uncut fieldstones. All of the joints are mortised and tenoned.

The small barn to the south was built after 1900, and has toenailed joints and a "drive through". It contains a complete tobacco-prisey in use until the 1940's.

The farm belonged to the Darnall family and was part of the Portland Manor grant. There was a large house on the property but the site is no longer visible. The family graveyard remains, however, in a small enclosure in the field below and to the south of the barns. Names are still visible on some of the stones. Large shrubs: yew, cedar and box-wood fill the space.

The site of the Crandell and Sheperd store, which appears on the 1860 map, is marked by a grove of large oak trees near the barns and directly beside Route 258. The building, which had been converted into a house, was destroyed when the highway was widened.
