DESCRIBE THE PRESENT AND ORIGINAL (IF KNOWN) PHYSICAL APPEARANCE

Parks Tenant House is located on the north side of Nutwell Rd. at Rt. 2 (Solomons Island Road). The structure is a two story, 1 bay x three bay frame I house with a one story frame wing perpendicular to the rear elevation. The main block faces south. Both parts of the building resemble the Glebe Farmhouse (AA-332), a dwelling of the same size and style with a a wing on the rear which is believed to date from the 18th century. Asbestos shingles cover all but the shed on the north elevation of the kitchen wing. A four bay porch with a shed roof supported by plain posts extends across the front of the dwelling , and the wing has a shed on the north elevation. The main entrance is in the center bay, front elevation. Windows are evenly spaced on the main block. They have 6/6 light double hung sah on both sections. The main block has a gable roof of medium pitch and small brick, indide end chimneys. The wing has a steep roof, covered with wood shingles and an exterior chimney on the north elevation. Both sections have simple box cornices.

STATEMENT OF SIGNIFICANCE

The Park's Tenant House is a typical 19th century frame [w]house with a kitchen on the rear. The structure is three bays long and one room deep under a gable roof with small inside end chimneys. The primitive appearance of the kitchen is probably due to the persistence of this type of construction over hundreds of years, rather than an early date of construction.
