DESCRIBE THE PRESENT AND ORIGINAL (If known) PHYSICAL APPEARANCE

A small, one story, frame, cottage with board and batten siding, the "tea-house" was used in the early 1900's as a gathering place for travellers and the West River Community. It was open in the evenings for dances and boasted one of the only gramophones in the neighborhood. The side roads were unpaved and often turned to mud in winter but Route 2 (Solomon's Island Road) was the main access between Annapolis and southern Maryland so this establishment enjoyed a good location on what was known as Walnut Tree Hill.

Miss Anne Cheston was the daughter of Dr. James Cheston of Owensville.
