DESCRIBE THE PRESENT AND ORIGINAL (if known) PHYSICAL APPEARANCE

The Severna Park Station on the Washington, Baltimore and Annapolis Railroad was built in 1919. It was one of three enclosed stations on the Line between Baltimore and Annapolis and was the only one built of brick and furnished with heat.¹

The station is a long, low building with a hip roof. The walls are brick, laid in Flemish bond, with the headers a darker color than the stretchers. The roof is made of slate and has a wide overhang. A martin house, with a weather vane at its peak has been placed at the center of the roof-ridge. Hanging from the eave at the north end of the building is the sign identifying the station. It appears to have been repainted recently.

There are two entrances to the building: one on the track side and the other opposite it, facing Holly Avenue. The windows all have 6/6 panel sashes, brick flat arches and concrete sills. There are four windows on the track side, two on the Holly Avenue side and one facing McKinsey Road. A brick chimney rises beside the door on the Holly Avenue side.

The Severna Park Station appears to have been well maintained since the railroad was abandoned. It is now occupied by the Severna Park Model Railroad Club.





