DESCRIBE THE PRESENT AND ORIGINAL (if known) PHYSICAL APPEARANCE

This house and the surrounding 200 acres belonged to Joseph Shepherd, according to the 1878 county atlas. Shepherd was a farmer who owned 1000 acres in the area around Bristol. His home was located farther north on the Mt. Zion Road.

The present owner is a descendant of Joseph Shepherd. The house is not in good condition and little is known about the history of it.

It is a two-story frame structure, well-built (probably not intended as a tenant house) and is of an unusual style. The plan is almost square, under a hip-roof with deep, boxed eaves. The house stands on a brick foundation and is sheathed in plain horizontal siding. The corners are covered with vertical boards and there is a wide fascia under the eaves.

The windows on the first floor all have 9/6 pane sashes. Those on the second floor are 6/6 panes. The windows had shutters but they have been removed.

The front elevation is three bays wide with the entrance at the south end. The original door has been removed but the side panels and frame are intact.

The house probably dates from between 1860 and 1878 because it is not shown on the 1860 county map.
