DESCRIBE THE PRESENT AND ORIGINAL (if known) PHYSICAL APPEARANCE

The ^{residence} ~~house~~ is a 2 story, frame, farmhouse with gray-painted wood siding. There are three distinct parts to the plan. The west end of the main house may be the earliest part. It has three bays with a center entrance. The chimney rises on one side of the center bay. The siding on this section is of graduated widths, diminishing as it gets higher. The windows vary from 6 over 9 pane openings on the first floor front to 6 over 6 on the second floor. There is a tiny 4 over 2 pane opening on the west end of the second floor.

The east end of the house has a separate entrance. According to the owner, a doctor once lived in the house and had his office in this part.

The rear wing forms an ell and contains the kitchen.

The house has simple trim: shutters on the windows, an open porch across the front and a flat, scroll-cut, detail on each eave corner.

The land around this house was once a part of Portland Manor, belonging to the Darnall family. No building appears on this site on the 1860 county map. The name H. Hopkins and a structure are recorded for this location on the 1878 map. The house was probably built in the third quarter of the 19th century.
