The Eversfield House, located at 645 Fairhaven Road, Dunkirk, Anne Arundel County, MD is neither eligible for individual listing on the National Register, nor is it part of an historic district which is eligible for the National Register.

The house is a typical mid-19th century farmhouse, with a large center gable, two-and one-half stories high, with two chimneys on the southwest side of the building. It is a five bay house with a shed roof porch extending across the entire front facade. Decorative brackets and posts support the porch's roof. All of the windows appear to be 4 over 4 double hung sashes.

The County advises that the house presently has aluminum siding over the shingles shown in the 1974 Inventory form picture. Further changes have occurred on the interior which have made the house's integrity problematic.

Therefore, the Eversfield house is not eligible under Criterion C for the National Register of Historic Places. Furthermore, the house is not known to have any associations with persons or events of significance to our history and therefore is not eligible under criteria A or B.

DESCRIBE THE PRESENT AND ORIGINAL (if known) PHYSICAL APPEARANCE

The house, on a rise above Fairhaven, is a three bay frame structure with a central hall. It is two rooms deep and has two exterior chimneys at each end. The weatherboarding has been covered with wood shingle and several shed porches have been added. There is a gable over the center bay of the front, containing a small window. The roof is an A with a moderate pitch.

The interior has been much renovated and altered. The floors are not old, the mouldings and mantels are simple. The partition between front and back parlors is wood paneling with a painted grain. There is a wide center arch and a smaller one on either side. The design shows some attention to detail but is rather crudely executed. It is not known whether this partition is original to the house.
