DESCRIBE THE PRESENT AND ORIGINAL (If known) PHYSICAL APPEARANCE

The first house on this site survived shelling by the British in 1812 but was burned to the ground in about 1815 by an irate housekeeper who was repeatedly locked inside by the owner.

The present house was built, sometime after, for the overseer of the Nutwell farm. The simple wooden mantel in the south parlor was supposedly taken from the ruins of the first house.

George Nutwell had another farm near what is now known as Nutwell Road. He moved his family to this house on Rockhold Creek after a fire destroyed his own house. His son, Captain Tom Nutwell, took over the farms and continued to live in this house. "Cap'n" Tom had several children. The oldest was born 98 years ago. The present owner, in her 80's, is another of, in her 80's, his children. The Nutwells raised tobacco and also had a large peach orchard where Highview on the Bay is now. The farm has been sold and the house now stands on eight acres, surrounded by large trees with a view of the bay across Rockhold Creek.

The principal section of the house has a 5-bay facade. The structure is frame with two stories under an A-roof of relatively low-pitch. There is an exterior, brick, chimney at each end. The eaves and gables have a heavy cornice with brackets over a wide fascia. The walls are covered with horizontal, lapped, wood siding. A screened porch also with a cornice and brackets, extends the length of the facade. This section of the house is one room deep with a center entrance hall and stair.

There is a low, one story, 2-part, wing on the south end of the main house, and a 2-story ell on the east side.

Several small out buildings stand near the house. One is a meat house with vertical, butt-jointed siding.
