

Three storeys of 2 bays - common bond with header row every 6th course. Roof starts upward away from street. A building once ajoined this to the south (marks still on wall.) Back of building are two windows and a loading door on 2nd and 3rd storeys, thus building probably used for trade/shop etc. Due to age and scale (and proximity with No. 118) and possibility of City Gate, 110 should be preserved. Side is extremely pleasing visually.
