Good elliptical roof dormers with elliptical sash; timber lintels; transom lit door has later entrancement, stoop later.



4. NOTABLE FEATURES, HISTORICAL SIGNIFICANCE AND DESCRIPTION OPEN TO PUBLIC no

11 College Avenue is a typical town house of this period with three bays of 6/6 shuttered windows, raised front steps elliptical 6/6 roof dormers, one side chimney, etc. The dormers make house look earlier, but smooth paste brick is Federal or later. Simple brick cornice and window lintels are Greek Revival. House would be worthy of restoration - an attractive member of an historic block.

11 $\frac{1}{2}$ College Avenue next door has Victorian cornice and form stone facade, however, layout of windows with their granite lintels and sills make earlier date, such as that of No. 11, probable.




