

The College Avenue Baptist Church is a good example of revived Gothic Revival with a very fine interior plan of the auditorium type. Built of Masonry the church has an English feeling with its large stained glass tracery windows their shape reminiscent of the altar windows in some English cathedrals (e.g. Gloucester). There is a square "Military Gothic" corner tower. Good example of type - only possible improvement would be painting window tracery a darker color.




