4. NOTABLE FEATURES, HISTORICAL SIGNIFICANCE AND DESCRIPTION OPEN TO PUBLIC no

107, 109 and 111 Conduit Street form a group of Victorian houses all basically the same; all have front porches, 2/2 windows, and bell cast mansard roofs with 2 dormers. 107 has brown wood shingling and elliptical Edward Hooper-like dormer windows. 109 and 111 are practically identical. 109 has variety weatherboarding, 111 has asphalt siding. 107 is good example of type; whole group should be preserved. (See 1, 97 and 99 Cathedral Street).
