



NOTABLE FEATURES, HISTORICAL SIGNIFICANCE AND DESCRIPTION OPEN TO PUBLIC yes</p> <p>The Dockside A. and P. store represents a period in America when certain commercial establishments designed buildings that were consciously "modern". The wall surfaces are completely unadorned (except for A.&P. signs) in a conscious imitation of European International Style. This period is also marked by the use of glass bricks. Though hardly an outstanding piece of architecture (it is still too close to us for objective evaluation) it is far superior to the ludicrous "castrated colonial" that A. & P. now builds.</p>
