Pressed metal cornice; segmental second floor windows with drip molds; c1940 shopfront with imitation marble and Carrera glass.




Stevens Hardware Store occupies a rather grand, simple, yet dignified Victorian commercial building. The 1st floor store front has been redone in 1940s vintage imitation marble glass. The building above the store is completely unaltered. There are seven 6/6 elliptical windows with granite sills and topped by protruding header brick drip moldings. The cornice is a simple extended one with a floral bracket at each end. The Randall Street side presents a large brick area, which has an advertisement printed on it; such painting can be attractive and should be the only kind of large scale advertisements allowed in Annapolis. A good example of the Civil War period, this handsome building is an important component of the Market Space.


