

213 Duke of Gloucester looks like many 19th C. Annapolis houses, however, 213 looks more Greek and less Victorian than the majority of the others. There is one triangular roof dormer (2/2) and an offset chimney. There is a Victorian jig-saw cornice and all windows are 2/2, however, there are molded cap lintels, small corner pilasters, and a doorway that is definitely Greek. Building has important location (211 Gloucester is frame dwelling of same scale), and research should seek to establish erection date (1845?).


