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Excellent gable end to street with projecting parapet and chimney at apex, chimney brest with corbeled pointed arch band and pointed arch blind window opening, second floor with large pointed arched window now infilled with brick, excellent corbeled brick decorative band at second floor line, interrupted at pointed gable entrance which is flanked by pointed arched triangular shaped stained glass half windows; entrance has pointed arch within the tall gable frame, brick pilasters with corbeled caps, bays at sides defined by corbeled buttresses, one of which returns at ends of front elevation; pointed arched windows at side elevations, second floor, some with original stained or hammered glass.



STATEMENT OF SIGNIFICANCE:

Exceptional Gothic Revival church structure now in office use, once part of St. Anne's the Calvary Baptist Church and a synagogue. Excellent as a type and critical to streetscape especially in relation to the Brice House, across East Street.


4. NOTABLE FEATURES, HISTORICAL SIGNIFICANCE AND DESCRIPTION OPEN TO PUBLIC yes

Historically and architecturally an interesting church, Calvary Baptist has been the church for different denominations including being a synagogue. Though rather unappreciated at the moment this church is one of Annapolis' potential gems. A superb example of "Victorian Gothic" - proto-modern of the "Frank Furness type". Typical upstairs auditorium interior, there is some good period stained glass and some very fine brick work. The west end with its squared "steeple" echoes and complements the west end profile of the Brice House. Preservation is a must and could easily be adopted to non-ecclesiastical office space, etc., leaving exterior intact.


