

Gabled dormer with returns; simple wood cornice and torus mold trim at windows and transom lit door, where there is a later poorly designed triangular hood on slender columns.



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
239 and 241 Hanover Street are adjoining structures sharing a single central chimney and a simple wood cornice. Each has a roof dormer with 6/6 elliptical windows and steep triangular roofs. Houses have modern siding but 6/6 shuttered windows show potential of these two buildings. Next to fine Greek Revival house and as well as another early structure. Well worth restoring.


