

235 King George Street was originally built as the kitchen of the Chase Lloyd House and on the exterior, only the house's location in relation to the Chase House and its giant central chimney show its culinary origins; the interior shows "kitchen" quite clearly. Presently a residence, the "kitchen" is a Greek Temple form building, the pedimented ends facing College and Maryland Avenues. A small structure, 2nd storey windows are proportionately smaller. Located near very important buildings, 235 King George is a good example of a Federal-Greek transitional piece.




