It is one of the few buildings in Annapolis with half windows (3/3) on the 3rd floor. 2nd floor windows are nicely proportioned (6/6) and have shutters. Though attractive architecturally, 91-95 Main St. is in poor shape. Any attempt at replacement should consider building in sympathetic scale, as whole block is important.	2.
