Heavy cornice with end consoles and molded band simulating frieze panel; brick splayed arches with marble keystones, first floor redesigned c 1978.



This building is important because it forms half a pair with 133 Main, and also it tends to soften the height of Hopkins Furniture Store. Needs only store front restored, plus woodwork painted.</p>
