



<p>These two buildings have been almost completely disguised on the Main Street side, however, shape, slope of roof, exposed bricks on side and rear show buildings to be early, probably Federal. One early Victorian cornice remains on 138. Facades should be restored, for buildings are important to streetscape, for they soften the impact of 140 Main Street. Doubtful that any replacement would do as much. Could be made very attractive by restoring store fronts; brick undoubtedly under stucco, window mullions and shutters needed.</p>
