Gable dormer with returns, box cornice, molded caps at first floor window and transom lit door, later planting bed and wrought iron railings.



Front siding is later (19th C.) and the door is not original, but everything else is, including the panes of glass. The roof dormer is triangular with returns and has pointed flashing. All windows are 6/6 and 1st floor window and doorway has molded caps. There is a simple wood cornice. Present occupants are restoring 112. Has small walled yard between it and 110, a house built at about same time.</p>
