



These two adjoining houses look stylistically like Federal town houses and as such, are quite handsome. There is a single chimney in the center of the roof and a 6/6 triangular dormer on each side of it. Both houses have two (6/6) shuttered windows on the 2nd floor, and a slightly taller (6/6) shuttered window, plus doorway with transom on the 1st. No. 128 has asphalt siding, while 130 has natural wood shingle. A handsome pair.

Gable dormer with returns, boxed cornice, molded trim at all windows and transom lit door, later brick stair and wrought iron rail in keeping


