

132 Market Street was originally almost identical to its neighbors (130,134) however, it has gone through extensive "Colonialization". New siding has been put on, 6/1 windows with "quater moon" shutters installed, and topped off by a Connecticut-Palladian doorway complete with fan light and semi-circular brick steps and wrought iron railing.

This house is indicated on the 1885 Sanborn Maps.
