Gabled dormer, simple boxed cornice; molded caps at windows and transom lit door, full width porch with unenriched entablature and slender turned columns.





134 Market Street has an Annapolis 6/6 triangular dormer on the roof, as well as the chimney at one end, and a side profile that makes the house look Greek Revival. Three 2nd storey windows (2/2) have cap molded Greek lintels and shutters. There is a front porch supported by 4 columns, plain entablature. 1st storey windows are larger version of 2nd storey windows. Door has a 2 light transom. Attractively painted red with white trim; presents handsome profile. Part of a "Federal-Greek" group.


