Gambrel roof end to street; paired brick chimneys; molded rakes and cornice, later entrance porch; later wing at right as garage.



DESCRIBE THE PRESENT AND ORIGINAL (if known) PHYSICAL APPEARANCE

11 Maryland Avenue is a 2 story (technically 1½) gambrel roofed brick house with the gable end facing the street. The sides of the house are obscured by later (20th c. ?) additions which are also gambrel roofed and extend from the main roof on either side (perpendicularly). The one towards 15 Maryland Avenue serves as a garage, while the other extension serves as a connecting link (hyphen) to the Tilton House (#9 Maryland Avenue). With the exception of a Georgian revival, pedimented entrance porch (supported by plain columns and pilasters) and later cornice, the street facade of this house is unadorned. Two brick chimney stacks project from the ridge of the roof, the one toward the rear is larger, taller and is probably part of the end wall.

STATEMENT OF SIGNIFICANCE (Include Personages, Dates, Events, Etc.)

11 Maryland Avenue was probably built sometime around the time that its Siamese twin-neighbor, the Tilton House, was erected (ca 1740), for the brick work (no window lintels), the relative size of the windows and their arrangement, the gambrel roof, the end wall chimney, and the hint of a water table would all point to an early to mid 18th century date. It should probably be considered to be one of the group of early 18th century Annapolis gambrel roof houses, e.g. 49 and 53 Cornhill Street, 45 Fleet Street, 160 Prince George Street, etc.




