DESCRIBE THE PRESENT AND ORIGINAL (If known) PHYSICAL APPEARANCE

21 Maryland Avenue is a 2 story plus attic frame (clapboard) house built on a brick base. The plan of the house is a modified cruciform (or irregularly shaped 'T' with a short shank) with a 'transept' - projecting, semi-hexagonal bay on the north (Cumberland Court) side, near the rear. A similar semi-hexagonal bay projects on the street side of the house, forming the main feature of the facade. The plan is accentuated by the overhanging cornice of the attic story, which is especially pronounced over the polygonal side bay; there is gable running perpendicularly to the main roof gable. All the gable ends are shingled and have windows. A simple, three plain columned porch (with roof) of one story height runs across the street front. Windows are 1/1.

## STATEMENT OF SIGNIFICANCE (Include Personages, Dates, Events, Etc.)

21 Maryland Avenue, a mid-late 19th Century frame house, is architecturally somewhat picturesque with its overhanging cornice and polygonal bays, however, its serves the townscape function of forming one of the boundaries of Cumberland Court. It also acts as the visual terminus of the commercial block of structures which run from the church at the corner of Prince George Street; its scale thus sets off the rest of Maryland Avenue from impinging on the Hammond-Harwood House.




