

194 Prince George Street is a magnificent Victorian town house and along with 182 frames the Paca House. 194 has a fine, elaborate cornice and fine detailing such as marble steps, sills, voussoirs, and keystones. All windows are 1/1 and have interior shutters. The front door is a superb example of Victorian, heavy woodwork. House needs only little work, mainly removing 2 roof dormers, otherwise it should be preserved as good example from the Brown Decades. (200 is a smaller edition of this building with a colonialized 1st storey but worth saving as a complement to 194).




