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Fine Victorian style and delightful visually, 204-206-208 is a single building divided into 3 houses each with its own turret-like breakfront. All windows and doors have rounded tops with brick arches. A fine period cornice snakes its way round the roof line. 204 has original marble steps and thats all 206 and 208 need. Building worth saving; next to Federal period brick apartments of roughly same scale.
