Bell cast tower at right with round arched dormer and sash, heavy bracketed cornice continues as rakes at cross gable projecting pavillion, which has round arched vent in gable, massive returns with deep consoles; tower bay has modified Palladian window at second floor, round arches entrance below fan and double leaf door; pavillion section has paired elliptical arched windows at second, semi-octagonal bay at first with bracketed cornice. Second floor windows have brick arches and limestone keys and skewbacks. Two story bay at rear of left elevation with cornice breaking. One story addition at left with aluminum siding later.



NOTABLE FEATURES, HISTORICAL SIGNIFICANCE AND DESCRIPTION OPEN TO PUBLIC no</p> <p>243 Prince George Street is basically an Italianate Victorian shaped house (pedimented projections, etc.) but with decorations that show a flamboyant imagination. The cornice is very rich and heavy and it is repeated over the front bay windows, which in itself is superb Victorian. Other fine detailing includes stone keystones and voussoirs and a drip molding over the front door, above which is a Victorianized Palladian window. There is one rounded Hooperesque dormer on the roof. Important of itself and near other period structures, esp. that on corner of College Avenue.</p>
