Gabled dormers with returns, corbeled cornice; five bay second floor with original window openings; first floor altered.


RELATED STRUCTURES: (Describe)

STATEMENT OF SIGNIFICANCE:

Pair with 26-28 West Street, part of Ghiselin's Ordinary, where Jefferson and Monroe stayed during Continental Congress of 1784; altered but easily restorable as a continuation of 26-28 West Street, and with that structure critical to the streetscape.

Obviously a very old and once very fine pre-Revolutionary structure, No 30 West has original dormers (2) original window sash in 2nd storey, one original end chimney, original battlement end gables. All header brick and had 2 end chimneys, but it is still very handsome. First storey has been altered but second storey only window mullions have been removed (now 1/1). Very fine triangular dormers with returns. Extant battlement end gables - rare.

Note: corbelled bricks at bottom of brick battlement.
 Metal roof and flashing are original (early metal roofs) c.1830






