



Original panel (for advertising) over store(s) (actually one may have originally been two stores as panel is divided. 4 windows (6/1)- original window tops (6) and sash on 2nd storey - capped by original stone lintels. The building is topped by a remarkable frieze - cornice arrangement. This panel is topped by a cornice which is made up of inverted water table bricks. A row of such bricks also protrudes above windows and below frieze-panel. In panel, above @ window are indentations - the Federal-Adamesque trophy motif. (Though these are, and were probably intended to be empty). A superb little building.</p>

Two story bldg. of the commercial type. On first floor are three varying stores, however, 2nd story to cornice is original and unaltered. Rather rare are the two friezes located between 1st and 2nd floors and between upstairs windows and cornice. These friezes are stucco and are outlined with headers of white brick. White headers imitating drip moldings surround the 2nd story windows 7 (1/4) (rare motif). Extending cornice (c.18 ") is held up by 4 scroll brackets. Some original brick is on ground floor.

No. 62 least altered; it interestingly follows line of Calvert St. around corner. No. 60, a drugstore, has glass front (new). No.s 56-58 (originally $\frac{1}{2}$ of 56-60) has a breakfront arrangement, c. 1930's</p> <p>Both bldg.s are reminiscent of false front architecture more commonly associated with Mid-West and Far-West.
