

4. NOTABLE FEATURES, HISTORICAL SIGNIFICANCE AND DESCRIPTION OPEN TO PUBLIC no

A narrow residence this house was once rather handsome. Nicely clapboarded, painted grey with white trim on front, unpainted on side (beautiful rust color - probably original siding). Steep metal roof with dormer 6/6 window and a few remaining flashes on ridge, chimney on east edge of front roof. Front has two bays, 6/6 windows - Federal window and door treatment except pediments are Greek Revival. Door is not original. Straight, unadorned cornice. W. side of house has Greek Revival windows with shutters. Separated from other buildings by alleys on @ side. A very fine Federal-Greek transitional building. This house is sagging and appears in bad need of work - but one of the nicest buildings on the block and keeping in scale with other earlier buildings on this side of West Street.

6. LOCATION MAP (Plan Optional)


