1868, 1948

Nothing remains of the original Wesley Chapel. The present structure that stands 50' from the west side of General's Highway near Gambrills was built in 1948. It is an Italianate church and is stucco over brick. The land was given by Mary Baldwin for the purpose of building a chapel for freedmen in 1868. The Rev. Alexander Dennis was pastor of Wesley Chapel in the 1870's. The Rev. Dennis was twice pastor of Asbury Methodist Church in Annapolis. Adjacent to the church, on both the south and east sides is a large cemetery. This graveyard contains the remains of some of the areas well known free blacks. The grave of Nellie Togood is located there. She was in the employ of the Baldwin family for sixty years.

STATEMENT OF SIGNIFICANCE

Although nothing remains of the original Wesley Chapel the site is of interest to historians. The land was originally given for the purpose of building a chapel for freedmen in 1868. Mary Baldwin gave the land. The Baldwin Family is well known in the history of Anne Arundel County . This family also supplied the Methodist Conference with land for Baldwin Memorial Church and a Methodist meeting ground.

The Rev. Alexander Dennis was pastor of Wesley Chapel in the 1870's. The Rev. Dennis was twice pastor of Asbury Methodist Church in Annapolis. Adjacent to the church, on both the south and east sides is a large cemetery. This graveyard contains the remains of some of the areas well known free blacks. The grave of Nellie Toogood is located there. She was in the employ of the Baldwin family for sixty years.


