Christ Church Sunday School for black children was established in 1876. A deed for the property and school is located in Liber SH 10, Folio 420, in the Anne Arundel County Courthouse. It was filed by Richard G. Chaney for the Trustees of the Church. The Episcopal Church in Maryland was long sympathetic to the cause of slavery. This Sunday School for the expressed purpose of the religious instruction of blacks is the first occurrence of such an institution organized by the Episcopal Church in Anne Arundel County. This Sunday School has been destroyed. There are no ruins, and I cannot find its exact location upon the grounds.
