DESCRIBE THE PRESENT AND ORIGINAL (IF KNOWN) PHYSICAL APPEARANCE

This 2 1/2 story frame house is four bays wide by one bay deep, and faces south. Its hipped roof is covered with asbestos shingle; present siding is aluminum. There is a one-bay ell to the rear on the east side of the building.

Two-story, three-sided projecting bays appear on the east and west sides of the house, culminating in large hipped dormers. Another such bay occupies the west bay of the principal facade, where it is topped by a hexagonal tower with ogee-profile slopes.

A screened porch extends across the south and east facades, surmounted by a second-story transomed doorway adjacent to the projecting bay on the south facade. Windows vary in size; all are 1/1 sash.
