Based on the available information, the large frame bungalow, located on the west side of MD 3, south of MD 424 in the Crofton vicinity, does not meet the National Register criteria for individual listing. According to the inventory form, prepared in 1980, the large 2 1/2 story frame house is of some interest as it exhibits a variety of design characteristics of the "bungaloid" style, popular in the early part of the 20th century, but is larger in size than is typical for the style. In addition, in 1980, the property was embellished with a substantial collection of vernacular yard art. Based on the information provided by SHA, all of the yard art has disappeared. The house alone, though of some interest, does not appear to possess sufficient significance to warrant individual listing under Criterion C. In addition, it is not known to have been associated with any significant event or person and thus is unlikely to be eligible under Criteria A or B. Lastly, it is not located in any known historic district. In fact, it is located in an area of increasingly dense commercial development.

DESCRIBE THE PRESENT AND ORIGINAL (IF KNOWN) PHYSICAL APPEARANCE

This large 1 1/2 story house rests on a high concrete block foundation facing east. The building has a gable facade, with a two-story perpendicular section at the rear resulting in a T-form. A one-story screened porch with a central entrance and shallow-pitched gable roof spans the east facade; two 6/1 sash windows pierce the gable at the half-story. The south facade of the two-story section has a triple 6/1 sash on each floor, while the main block has a single 6/1 window in the south wall with a gabled dormer above it. Stickwork brackets embellish the broad overhanging cornices, and the rafter ends are exposed under the eaves.
