Union Memorial Methodist Church stands 20' from the south side of Rte. 214, $\frac{1}{2}$ mile from Davidsonville. The present stucco building was erected in 1952. During the Civil War the Davidsonville Methodist Church was the only Methodist Church in southern Anne Arundel County to withdraw from the Northern Methodist Convention and become a member of the Methodist Episcopal Church South. This group supported slavery. It left the black Methodists that had long attended the Davidsonville church without a place to worship. This situation caused the formation of Union Memorial Church.

Union Memorial Methodist Church stands 20' from the south side of Rte.214, 1/2 mile from Davidsonville. The present stucco building was built in 1952. It is a gable building measuring 26' across the front and is 48' in depth. The entrance is on the north east corner of the building and faces east. The building is of no architectural interest, but photographs and slides are included.

STATEMENT OF SIGNIFICANCE

Union Memorial Methodist Church is of interest to historians for two reasons:

1) During the Civil War the Davidsonville Methodist Church was the only Methodist Church in southern Anne Arundel County to withdraw from the Northern Methodist Convention and become a member of the Methodist Episcopal Church South. This group supported slavery. It left the black Methodists that had long attended the Davidsonville Church without a place to worship. This situation caused the founding of Union Memorial Church.

2) Union Memorial Methodist Church is the only black Methodist Church located in Davidsonville. It has survived in the wealthiest tobacco region for over 100 years. Union Memorial was also the site of the only Davidsonville Northern Methodist Convention Church for 36 years.


