This is a three bay wide, three story high, brick and stucco structure with wood tudor style design on the upper stories. The windows are one over one and some have awnings over them. The building is painted cream and brown and it is in good condition.

Significance:



The structure at 203 Davis Street dates from the early to mid-nineteenth century. This brick and stucco structure has been altered with a tudor style design. As late as 1911 this building was used as a dwelling, but since then it has been used for commercial purposes. 
