Description:

This two story high, two bay wide limestone building is relatively intact above the altered first floor level. The first floor has been covered over with a pebble-like material which surrounds the off-center, recessed glass and aluminum double door entrance and large show window. A large yellow "Yorkridge-Calvert Savings and Loan" sign completes the altered first floor. The second floor features large three-part windows with a decorative surround that is capped by a pronounced keystone. The windows are divided by half column mullions and feature transoms with a classically decorated grill. The cornice features elaborate end brackets and dentils.



This two story structure is representative of the small commercial structures designed by Baldwin and Pennington in the early twentieth century. This same noteworthy firm designed some similar, yet more elaborate structures on Charles Street in the Cathedral Hill area. The first floor of this building has been drastically altered and the second floor has been neglected.


