Description:

This three story high, one bay wide terra cotta building is presently under construction. The first floor is covered with plywood. The altered aluminum frame, large second and third floor windows are set into a terra cotta surround with projecting stones similar to a Gibbs surround. A plain metal panel is located at the third floor level between the windows. A large foliated keystone is located at the top of the bay. It is surmounted by two blank panels with decorative molding and foliated brackets supporting a cornice. The cornice features decorative consoles and egg and dart molding.



Although this narrow three story high structure is undergoing rehabilitation, the work is not in keeping with the original design of the building. The use of bronze aluminum on the storefront and upper floor windows detracts from the character of the structure. A more compatible storefront and upper floor window treatment would make this building a contributing element to the historic character of the Financial District.



