Description:

This relatively intact brick commercial building with terra cotta trim is four stories high and three bays wide. A new aluminum framed glass storefront is set into a foliated surround within the original first floor building walls. The upper floor Flemish bond brick building walls flank one over one windows and a decorative surround highlighted with quoins. Decorative keystones are located above the original windows, except for the central third floor window which has a small pediment with end brackets. Decorative terra cotta panels are located between the floor levels. A stone band course above the fourth floor level is surmounted by a decorative corbelled cornice.


This four story high, ornate commercial structure has not been altered a great deal. It is one of the more intact structures on the 200 block East Baltimore Street. The upper floors feature excellent terra cotta decorations. The arcaded treatment at the cornice is unusual for the area. Although a new aluminum and glass storefront has been installed on the first floor, it is set into the original surround with foliated molding. Early photographs and an original elevation of this structure exists, therefore, it is possible to restore the original storefront design for the building.



AN EAST BALTIMORE STREET STORE.



This building, which was designed by J. Appleton Wilson, is now in course of construction at 211-213 East Baltimore street for Mr. Dalrymple Williams by Edward Brady & Sons. The structure has a frontage of 27 feet and a depth of 104 feet. The face of the building will be of Harvard brick, with cream-colored terra cotta trimmings, which will make it attractive.
