Description:

This two story high structure serves as an entrance to the First National Bank parking garage. A large opening takes up most of the first floor. A door leading to the second floor is located to the south. The second floor is filled with eighteen blank panels. A projecting sign displaying "PARK" in large red letters is located on the second floor level. The building ends in a small shed roof.




