Description: This five bay wide, four story high, brick structure has wood and granite trim. The first story has been altered somewhat and features a recessed entrance covered by an awning and two other entrances and a window. Directly above the main entrance is the bright yellow Jake's Delicatessen sign. The window styles vary on each floor level. The second story has one over one windows, the third story has nine over one and the fourth story has six over one style windows. All the windows are set in segmental arches with brick voussoirs above and granite ledges. Above the fourth story is a wooden cornice with dentils and a brick parapet extends about two feet above.



Like 104-106 East Lombard Street, the building at 114 East Lombard Street was also built in 1906 and designed by the architect George Clothier, Jr. The building features windows set in segmental arches with brick voussoirs and a wooden cornice decorated with dentils. The structure is in good condition and adds to the historic character of the area.
