**Description:** This is a two bay wide, four story high, brick structure. To the right of the structure there appears to be a brick addition made to the original structure which is one bay wide and two stories high. The first story on both portions of the structure has been altered with awnings over the windows. On the original structure all the upper stories have windows which are three part, one over one recessed windows and there are diamond shaped brick patterns between each story. On the addition the second story window is a three part recessed window. Neither roofline has a cornice. The building is in good condition and contributes to the historic character of the area.


**Significance:**

Area: architecture

Level: local

The structure at 202-206 Water Street is actually identical to the structure at 23-25 South Calvert Street except the Water Street building is all painted over. This structure was designed by the same architect, Herbert G. Crisp, and in the same year, 1904 as the building at 23-25 S. Calvert Street. The building features some of the same details as its neighbors, such as diamond shaped brick and tile patterns. The building fits in well with the historic character of the street and it is in good condition.




Baltimore Financial District Survey
