Description: The large building at the corner of S. Calvert and Water Streets is a three bay wide, four story high, brick structure with granite trim. The first story features a centralized entrance, flanked by rectangular windows and the Oscar Scherr entrance and store window on the right and a large, three part window to the left. The first story facade is a rusticated brick and above the windows are diamond shaped brick and tile patterns between each story up to the roofline. The second through the fourth stories have recessed three part, centralized windows flanked by one over one windows. There is a two foot wide band of the diamond shaped brick and tile patterns above the fourth story and the roofline is without a cornice. The south elevation on Water Street is two bays wide with the same architectural style as the main elevation.


Significance:


