Description: This is a three bay wide, four story high, brick structure with granite trim. Unfortunately the brick on the first story has been covered over with wood. It features a central rectangular window flanked by entrances. A simple console cornice divides the first and second story. The second and third stories have two part, centralized segmental arched, one over one windows, flanked by single, one over one windows. The fourth story has smaller, round arched, one over one windows. Each window on the building is decorated with voussoirs above and granite ledges. There is an elaborate cornice which is slightly deteriorated above the fourth story. The facade extends two feet above the cornice and there is a narrow, unadorned cornice at the roofline.




The building that is presently occupied by Peter's, a bar and restaurant, was designed by Henry Brauns in 1904. The first story has been covered over with wood and a simple console cornice divides the first and second story. All the windows appear to be closed up as if none of the upper stories are occupied. Overall the building is in good condition and contributes to the historic character of the area.
